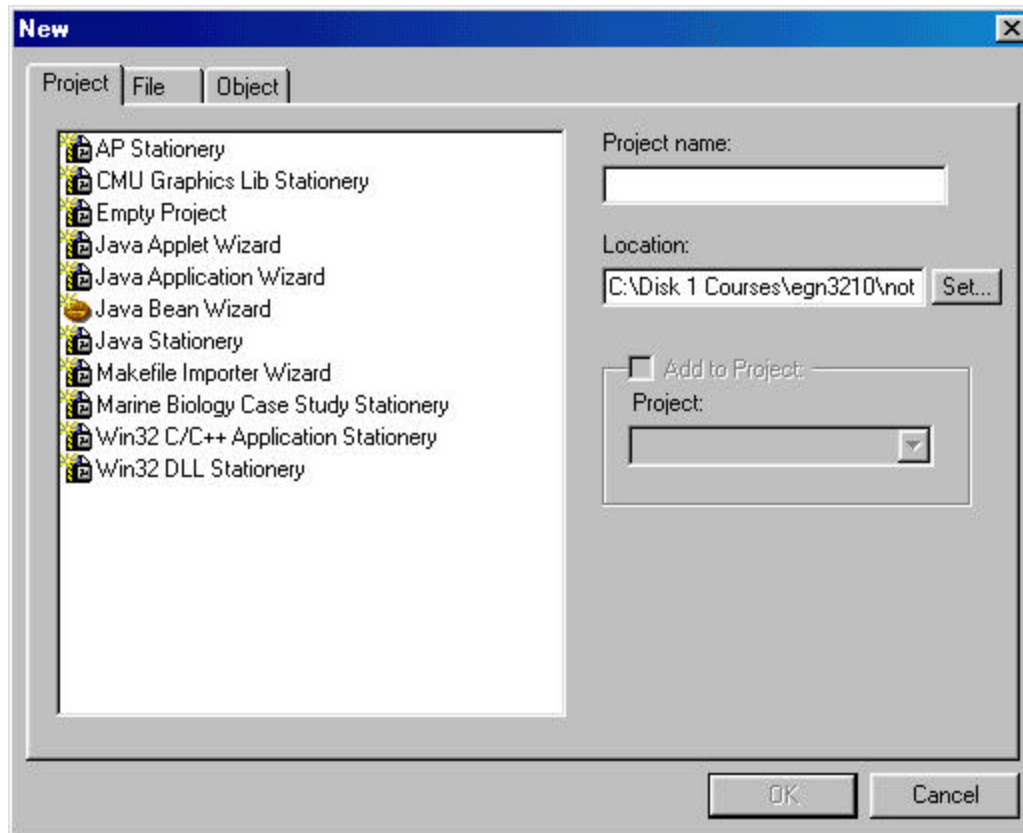


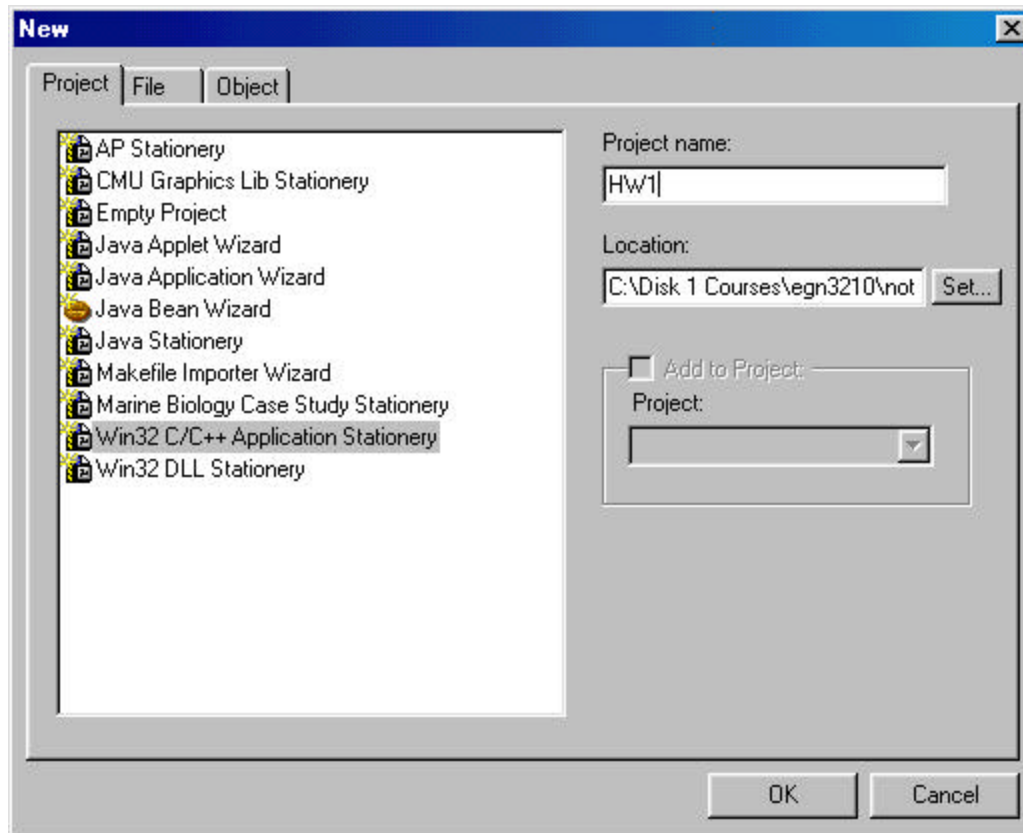
To run a program using CodeWarrior we first select the application from the start menu.
We get:



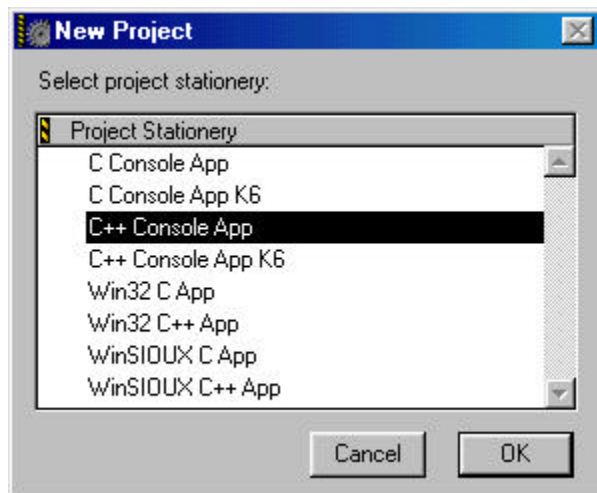
Next we select "new" from the File menu and get:



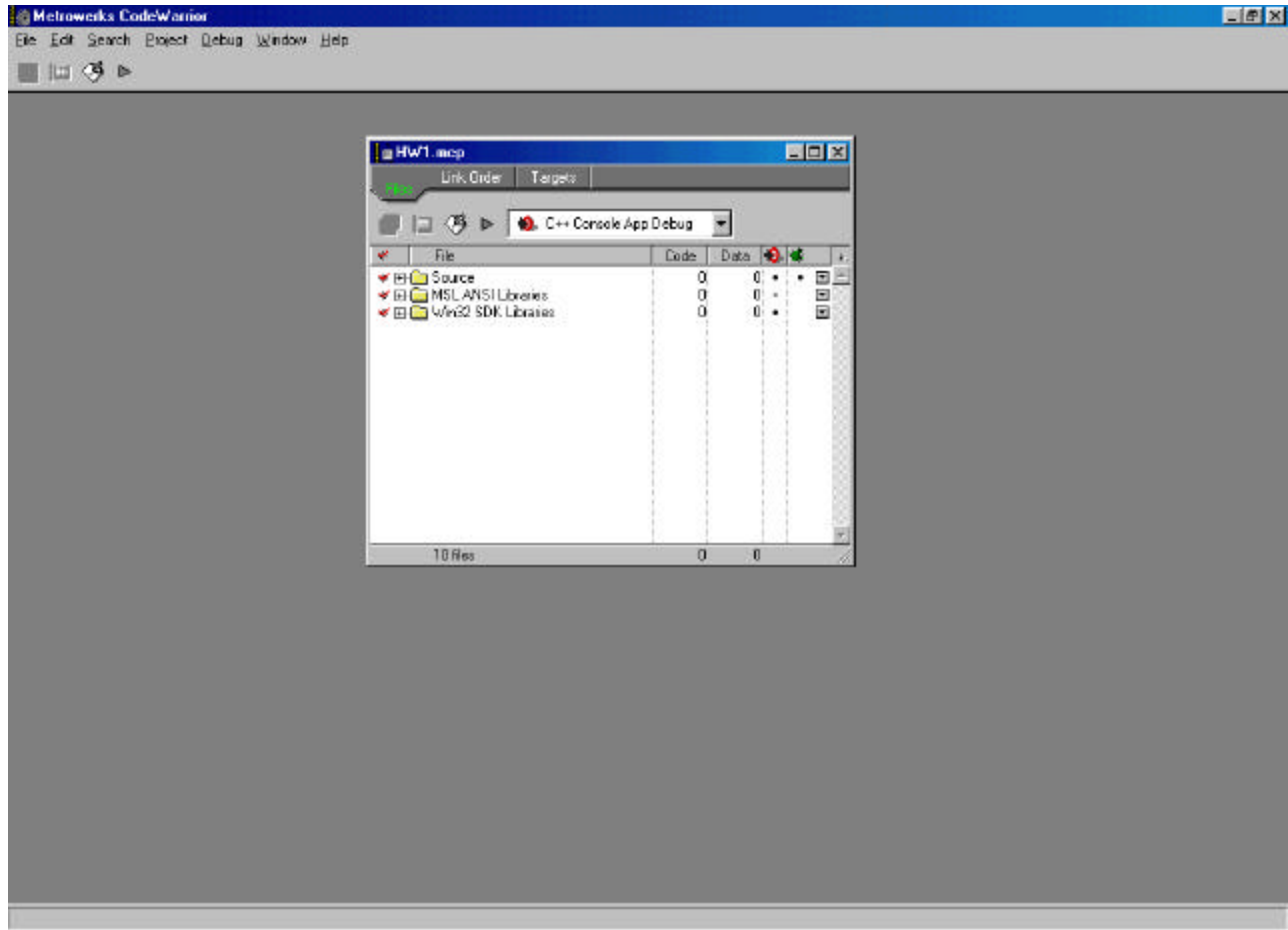
Next we select “Win32 C/C++ Application Stationery” and type HW1 in the “Project name:” box to get:



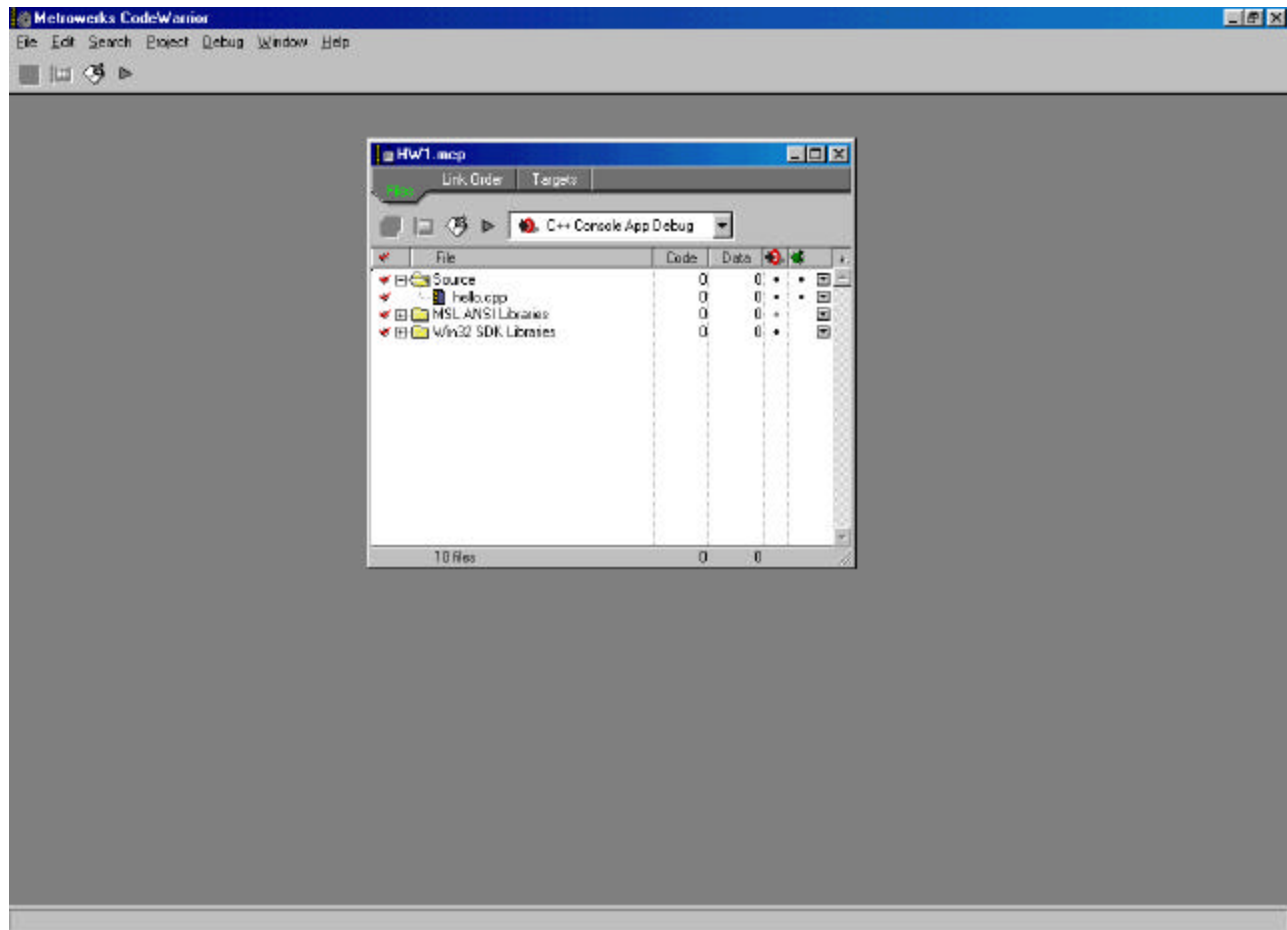
We next click the OK button and get:



Here I select "C++ Console App" and click OK to get:

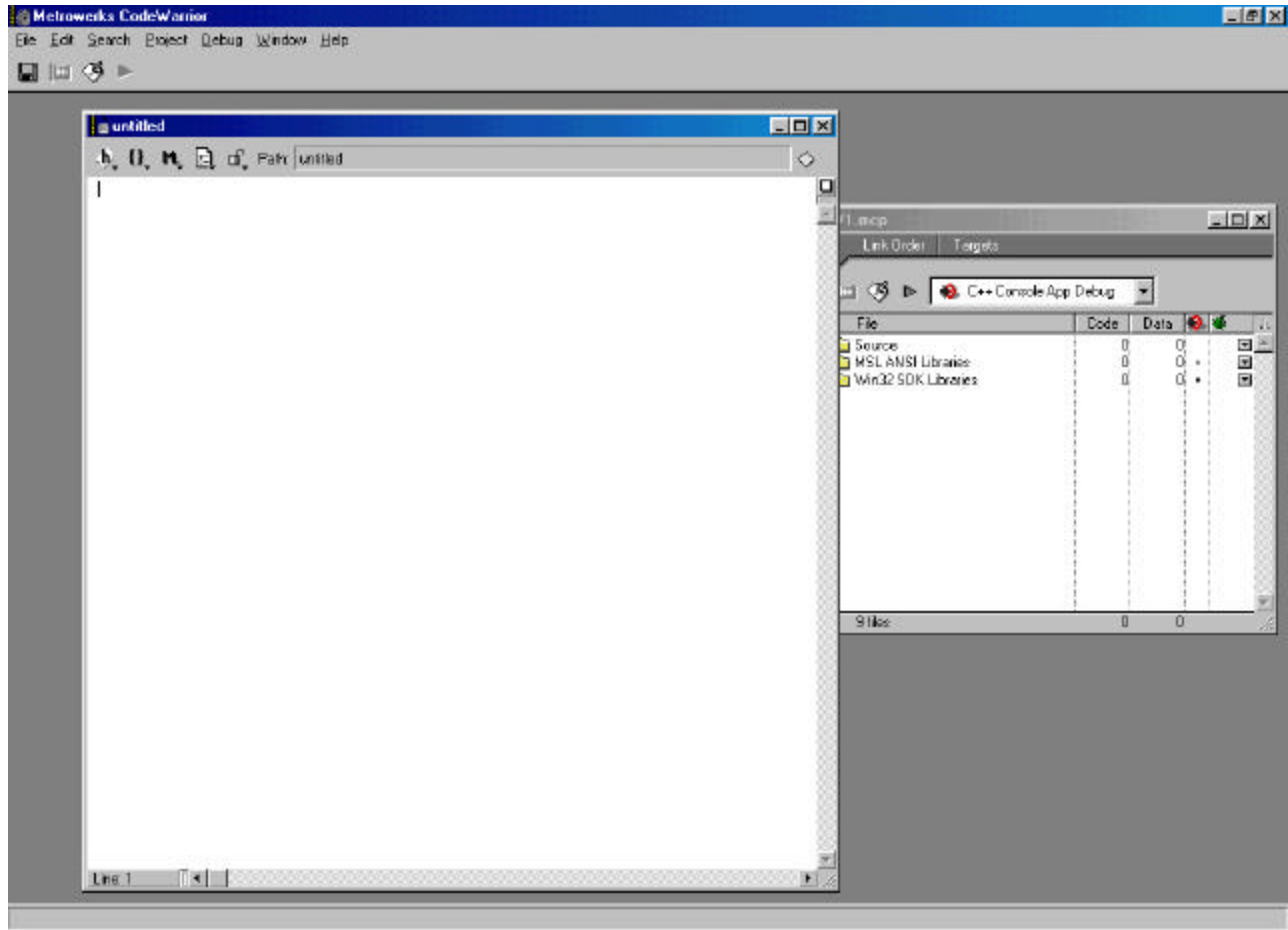


I click the “+” symbol in front of the “Source” folder to see what is inside of the folder. I get:

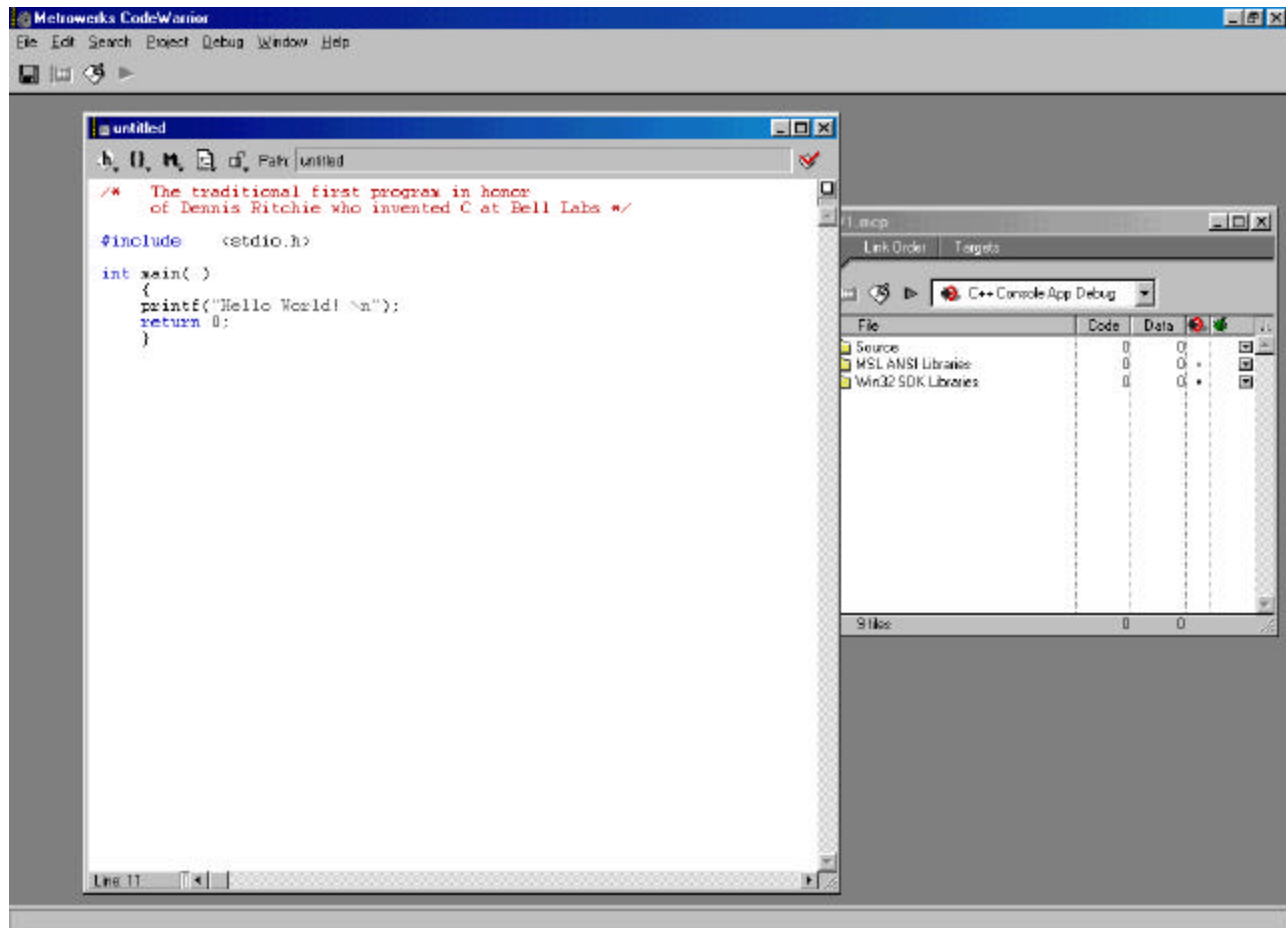


There is a source file already there for you. This is only an example. Delete this file since we will use our own.

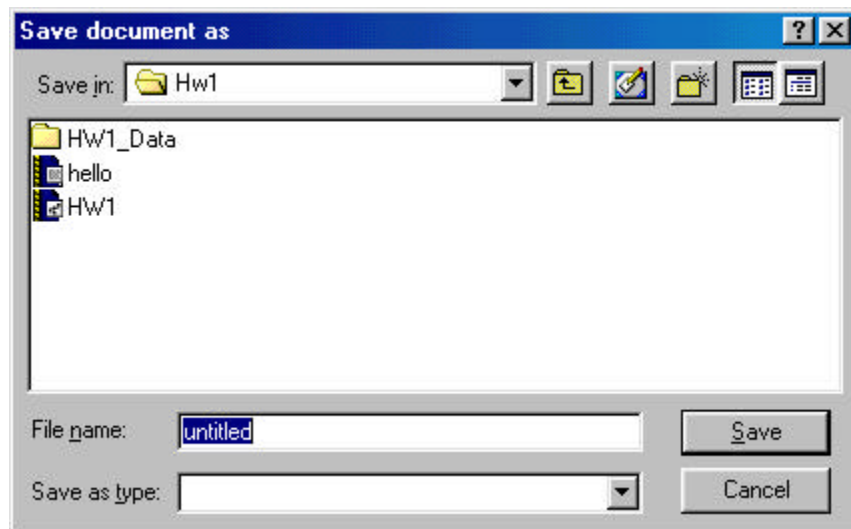
I then type "New Text File" from the file menu and get:



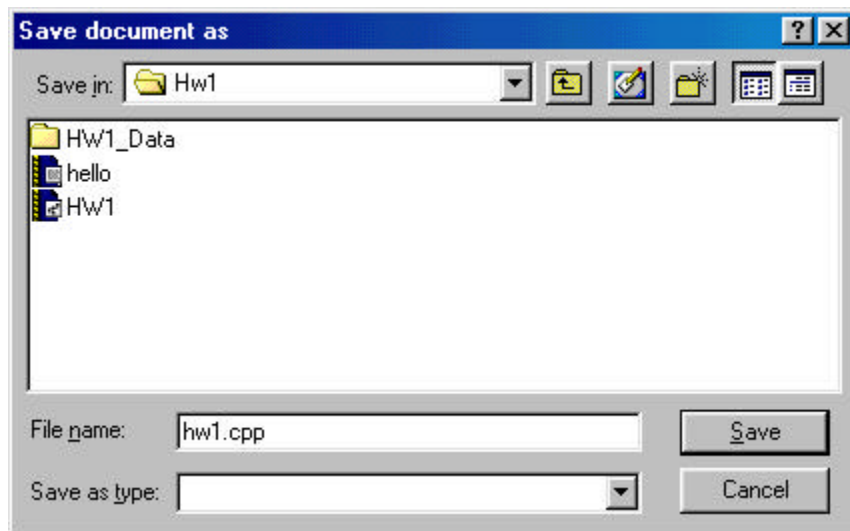
I now type the source code. I type in the hello world program from class to get



I next select "Save as" from the file menu to get:

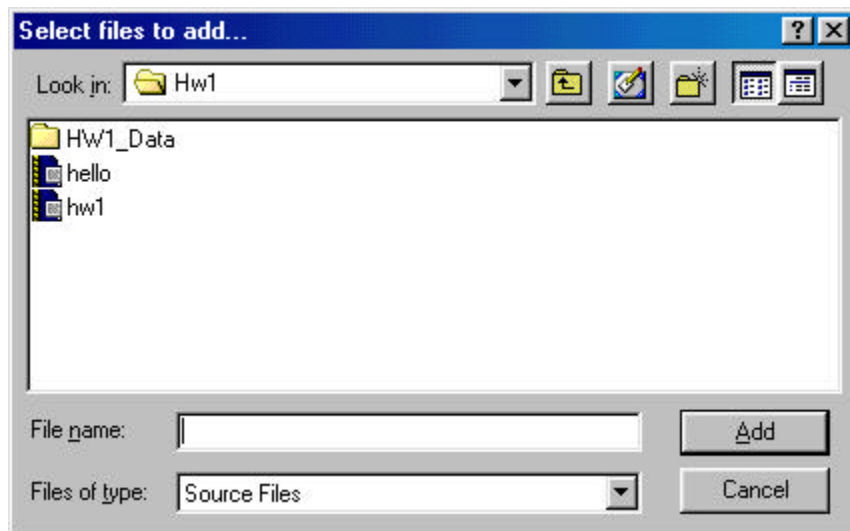


Where it says "untitled" I type the file name. Do not forget the cpp extension.

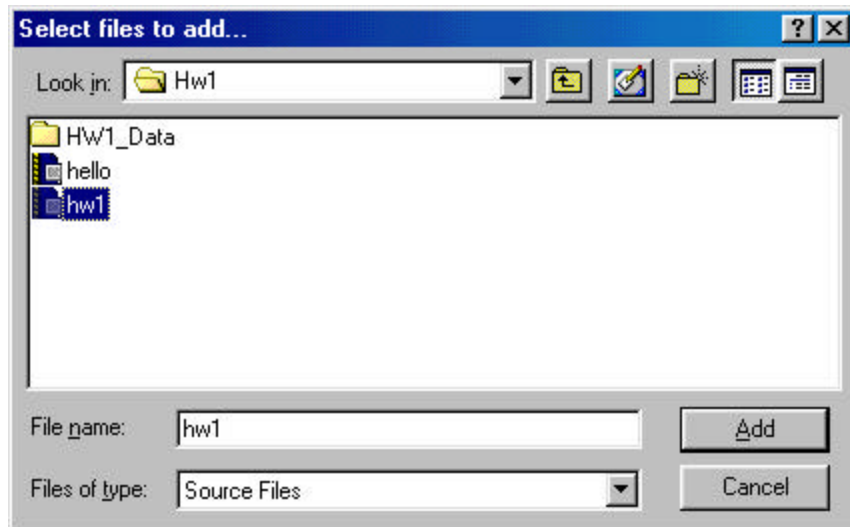


Now click the "Save" button.

Next I select "Add Files" from the Project menu to get:

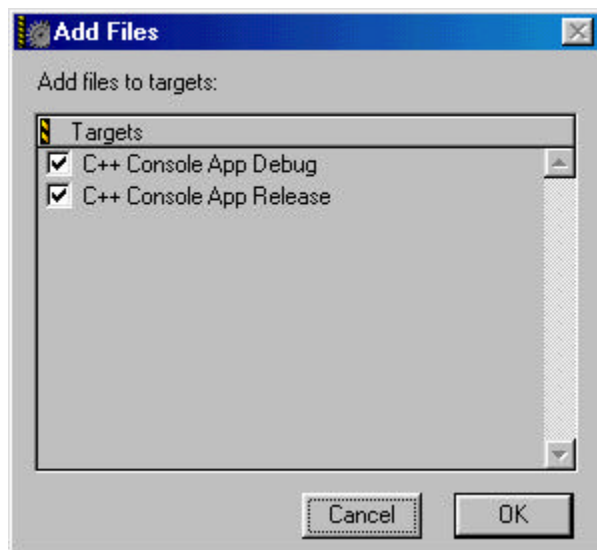


I select the file I just created, hw1.cpp, by clicking on it to get.



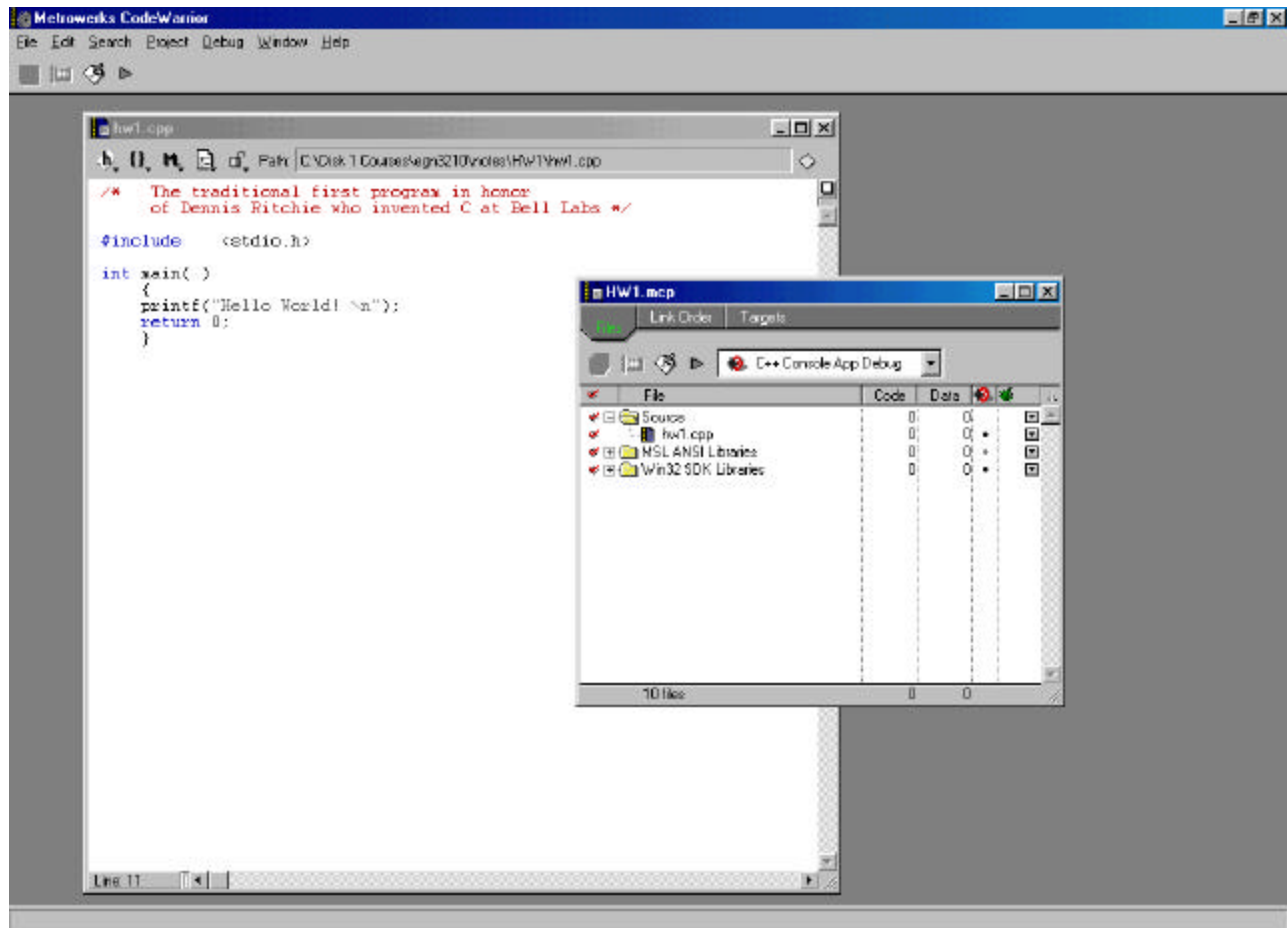
Note that if you did not save the text file as .cpp it will not show up here.

I next select "Add" to get:



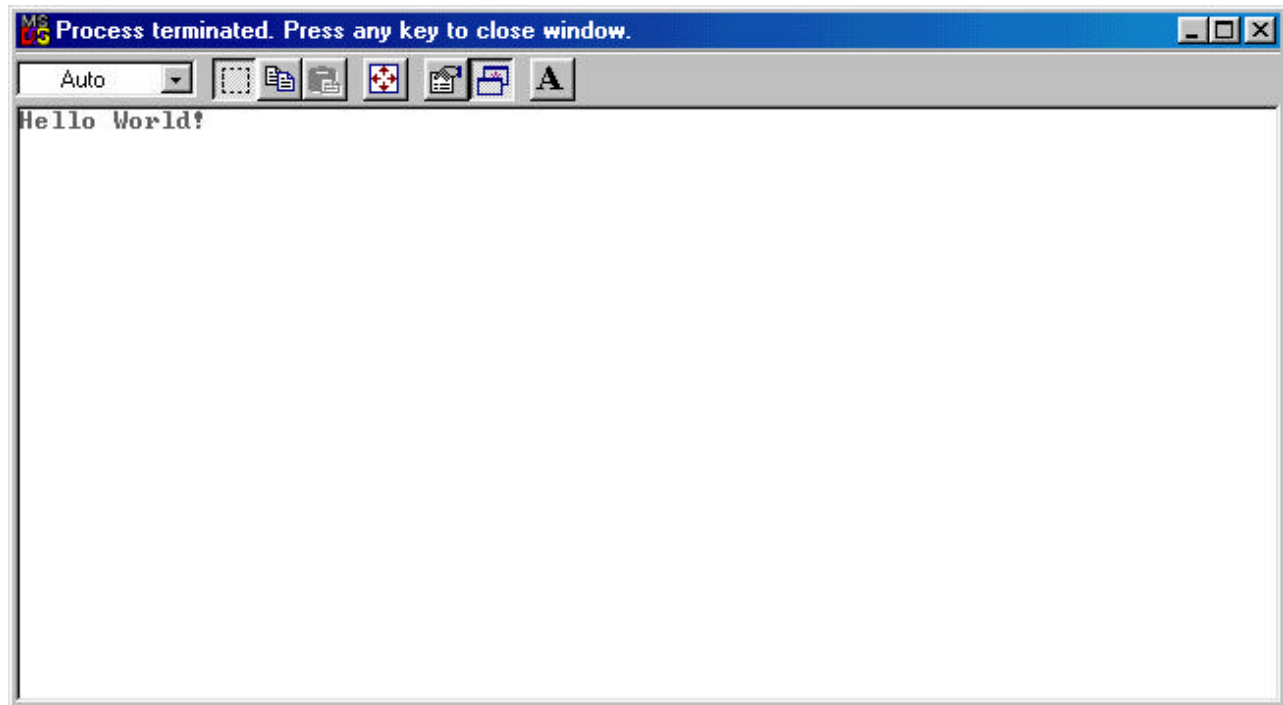
I simply click the "OK" button.

Now I have:



To run the program I select “Run” from the Project menu.

The compiler starts compiling the program. When it is done, assuming that you did not make any mistakes, it runs the program. I eventually get:



Now press “Enter” and you are back in CodeWarrior.

At this point you can modify the source code or quit.
