## What is Click it or Ticket?



- It is a program designed to give people a reason to buckle up. Some people like to buckle up for safety while others wear their seat belts to avoid tickets and the consequences such as points on their license and expenses. In *Click it or Ticket* programs, law enforcement agencies are being asked to mobilize to focus on safety belt violations and publicize the increased effort through new media and advertising.

- Click it or Ticket Florida is a statewide enforcement initiative surrounding some of the deadliest holiday weekends of the year.
- Research shows that regular safety belt usage is the single most effective way to protect motorists and reduce fatalities in vehicle crashes. Through this program, law enforcement agencies are able to promote traffic safety and ultimately save lives.



- This program is coordinated by the Florida Department of Transportation in conjunction with the National

Highway Traffic Safety Administration and law enforcement across the state. During this Click it or Ticket mobilization effort, zero tolerance will be shown for unbuckled motorists in an effort to reduce fatalities on Florida's roadways.

## Facts:

- Teens are at the greatest risk of being killed or injured in traffic crashes. In 2001, 3,322 teens were killed in motor vehicle crashes, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
- Safety belt enforcement is not about writing tickets, but about saving lives.
